This event is held under the auspices of APDSC. We kindly ask you to review the attached information regarding accommodation and related expenses.

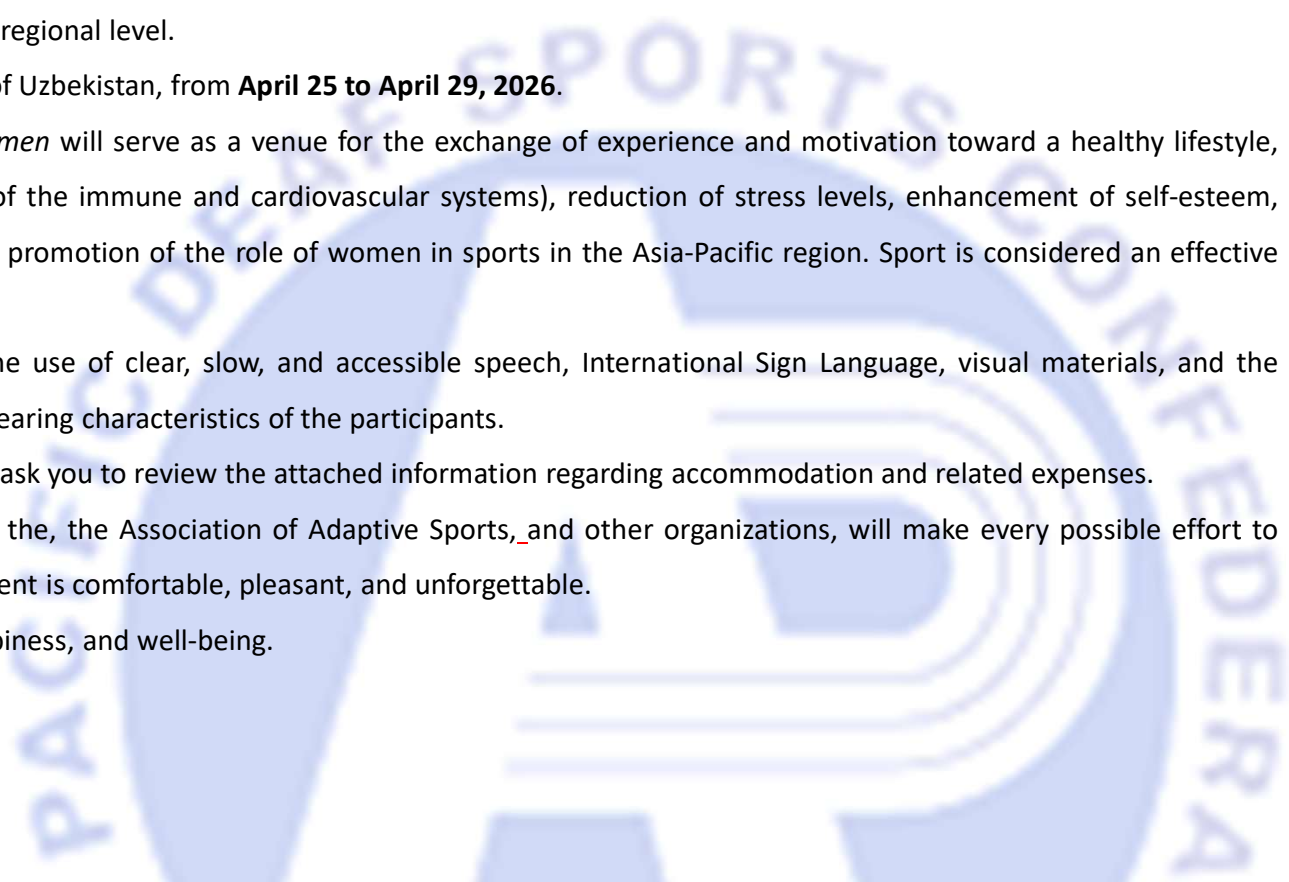

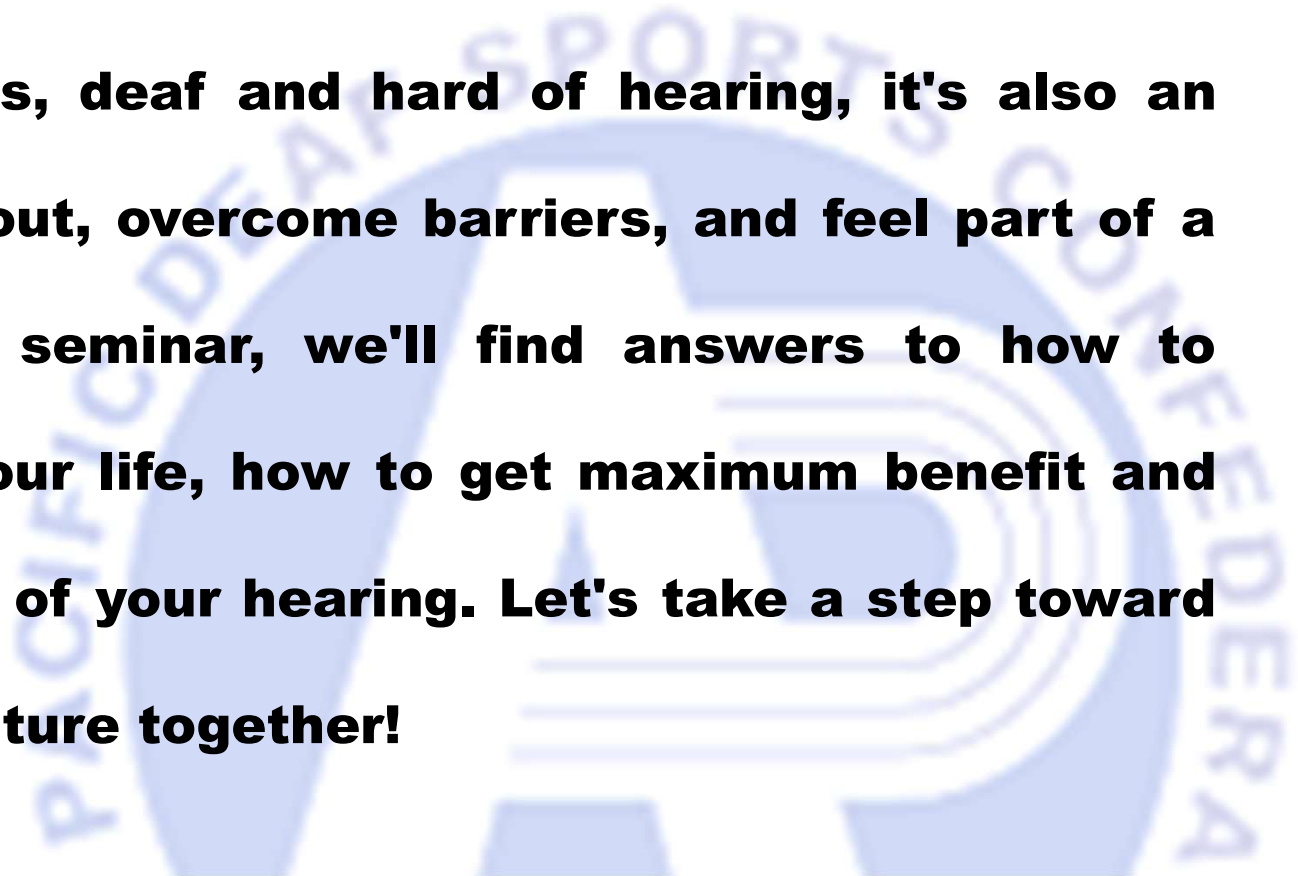
THERE ARE MANY FAMOUS MUSEUMS IN SAMARKAND
